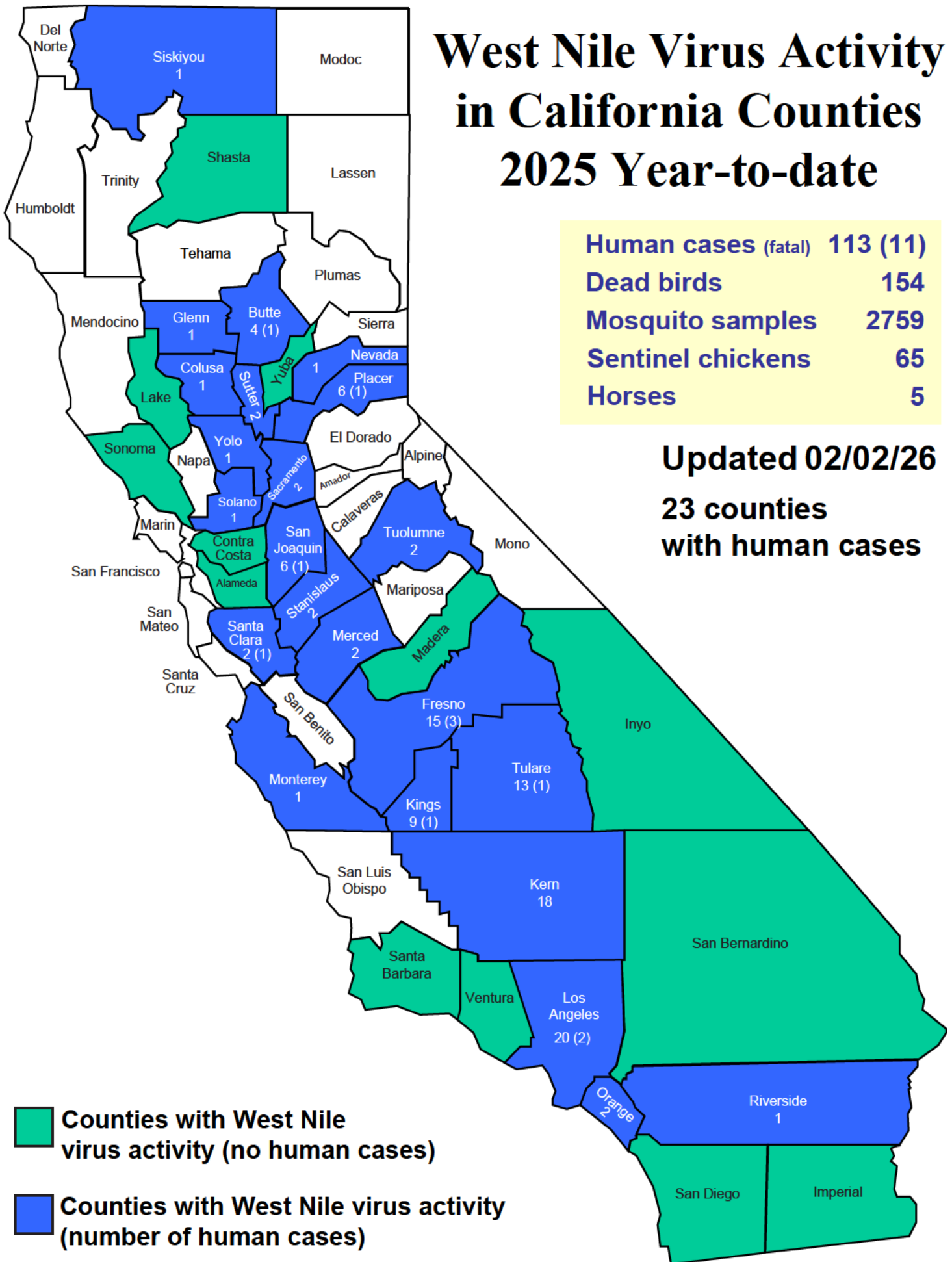

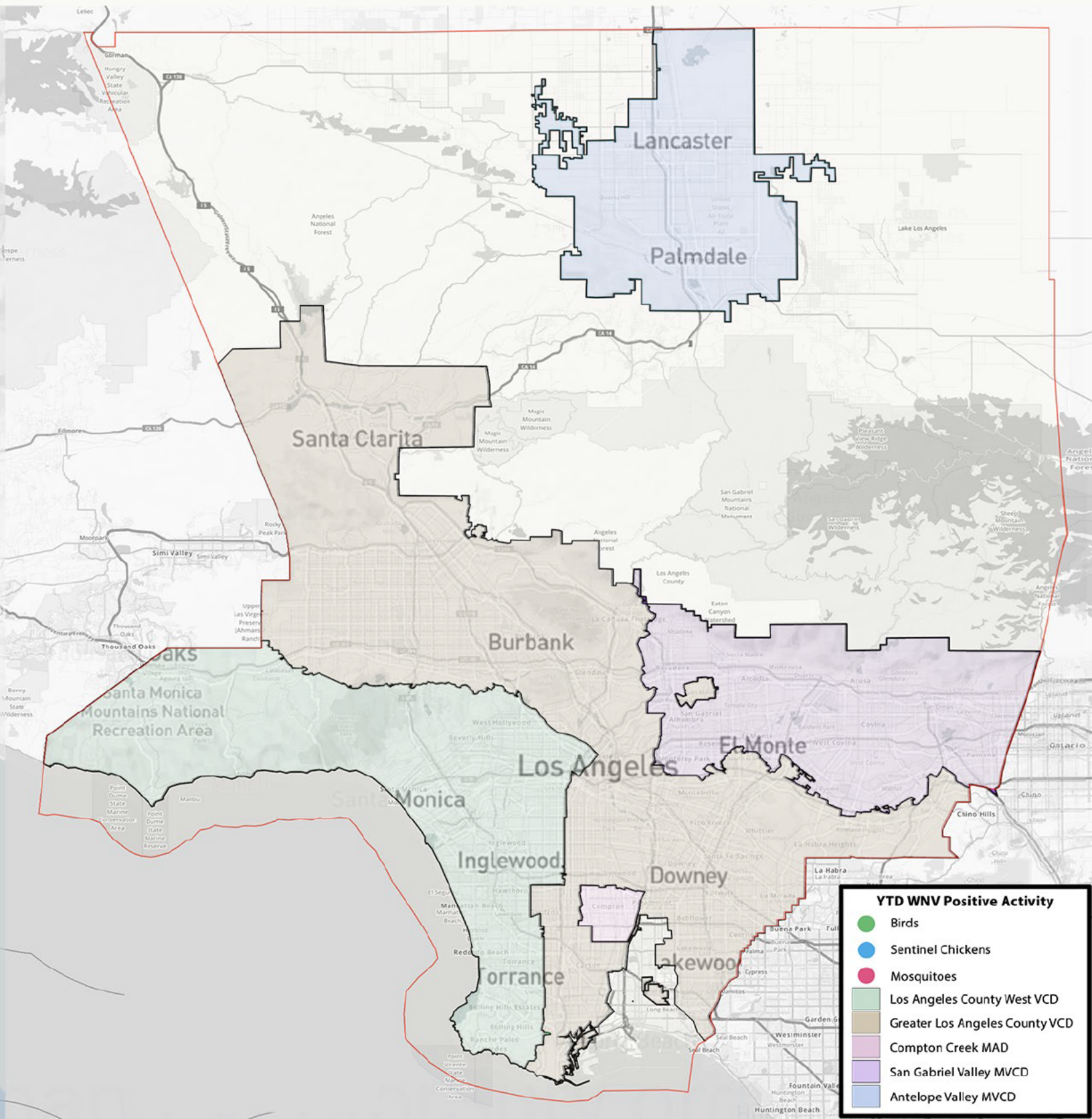

Public Education

PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

An essential program of the District includes educating the public about the life cycle of honeybees, mosquitoes, ticks, vector-borne diseases, property owners' responsibilities, and functions of the District. General public education is accomplished through the means of informational brochures, fact sheets, city bulletins, public speaking engagements, public service announcements, informational booths at community events, and the District web site (www.lawestvector.org).

SCHEDULING OF EVENTS

Field Operations

Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant

The Hyperion Plant currently has three offline primary battery collector tanks, three offline final clarifiers, and an emergency final clarifier overflow offline during this period. All offline subdivisions are monitored by Hyperion staff until maintenance work is fully completed.

Multiple mosquito breeding and potential mosquito breeding sites were observed during this period. Due to the rainfall, several flooded areas are being addressed by either treatment or dewatering. Screen mesh continues to be implemented throughout the facility for mosquito exclusion. District personnel continue to assist Hyperion with pesticide treatment and inspections within the facility. Mosquito trap counts were elevated during this period.
